The Decommissioning Ceremony is a time honored tradition which formally terminates the active service of the ship. A decommissioning is generally a somber occasion reflecting on the service of the ship during its commissioned period. The ceremony is intended to be short and far less elaborate than most other traditional naval ceremonies and terminates the total responsibility, authority and accountability of the Commanding Officer.
